IDEXX dermatology consultants are responsible for telephone consultation with vets regarding interpretation of reference laboratory and in-house instrument results, as well as regarding treatment of their dermatology patients. We are seeking a service oriented individual who can provide high quality, practical advice in a timely manner to our colleagues in practice as well as liaise with our pathology and operational teams regarding advancements in Dermatology. The successful applicant will also be expected to promote the growth of IDEXX Laboratories, by actively participating in veterinary CPD meetings and maintaining other professional contact with veterinary surgeons.



PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:
